



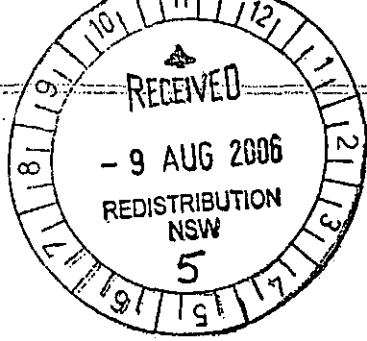

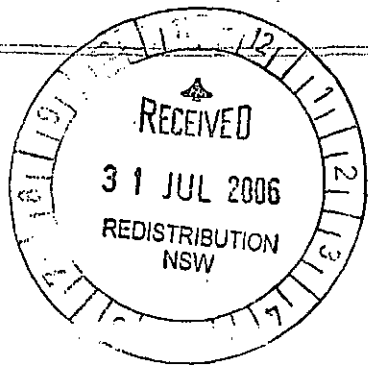
I will be grateful if you accept my submission as a "comment on objections" which you kindly suggested.
