

I am writing this to give my strong objection to the abolishment of the Gunnedah electorate and joining it with the Park electorate.

The size of the new electorate makes it impossible for one member of Parliament to give fair and equal representation to every local government area - 19 in all - which would be in the proposed seat of Parkes.

Has due consideration been given to the size of the proposed electorate? Nearly half of N.S.W. This considerably reduces the voice of country people in the Federal Parliament.

Country people do not have - unlike city people - in close proximity to their Member of Parliament and in the new electorate would have to travel many miles and many hours and hours to see their MP.

To me this proposed new electorate just shows again the ignorance of people who do not live in a rural area. They have absolutely no knowledge or care about, convolution under which county falls here; such as diversion of intersect, roads, and distances. The whole proposal is an insult and quite unacceptable to rural communities of N.S.W.

The creation of an electorate of the size will certainly reduce the voice of country people in the Federal Parliament - as stated before - and less than consideration must be given to the voice of the people who will be most effected by this proposal. People do live west of the Great Dividing Range and of those of you who fit comfortably

behind your desks in your easily accessible office would take a bit of time to see for yourselves just what it is like in rural areas where so much of Australia's wealth comes from you might realize that the people living there are deserving of far better treatment than this proposed amalgamation or offscie. It is an insult to them.
