The Lower Namoi Cotton Growers Association (LNCGA) represents over 150 irrigated and dry land cotton growers in the region from Narrabri to Burren Junction. We wish to abstain most strongly to the abolition of the seat of GWYDIR in the proposed redistribution of Federal Electoral boundaries in New South Wales.

It is absolutely ridiculous to propose that one person could adequately serve the needs to an electorate that covers one-third of the area of New South Wales.
