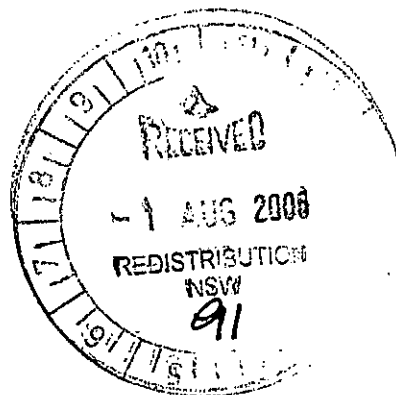

I am writing to you on behalf of the Quambone Branch of the National Party.

I would like to convey our concerns to you, the AEC, about the proposal to abolish the seat of Gwydir and merge the seat into Parkes.

Firstly, the voice of country people in the Federal Parliament would be considerably reduced, and secondly, the area proposed would be almost impossible for one person to move around and speak with their constituents. Both of these points illustrate that the proposed changes would not bring fair and equitable representation to the Parliament.
