To The Members of the Redistribution Committee,

I am writing to you today to lodge a strong objection to the proposed name for the new Federal Electorate, soon to be officially named "Wright".

I am of the opinion that this name is totally inappropriate for the region, for a number of reasons.

Judith Arundell Wright was born in 1915 in New South Wales and lived in that State and overseas until 1943, when she moved to the south-east corner of Queensland, where she lived for the next twenty years. It is quoted that she was a poet and an academic. If you were to ask the average person in the Central Queensland region, nine out of ten of those people would not have a clue who she was or what her profession was. In my opinion, she has no real or perceived connection with the Central Queensland area.

In fact, most people in Central Queensland immediately associate the name "Wright" with the ex-dis-honourable Federal Member for Capricornia, Keith Webb Wright. (Incidentally, part of the seat of Capricornia is proposed for the new seat of "Wright").

Keith Webb Wright was a former State and Federal Member for the ALP and Member for Capricornia during the 1990's. He was convicted of rape and indecent dealing with a girl under the age of fourteen years and sentenced to eight years imprisonment for his despicable crimes.

All of the time that he was committing these offences, he was a weekend Baptist preacher, preaching the protection of innocence of young children.

Most people in this area of Central Queensland vividly recall Mr Wright's predatory action with young girls, all under the guise of a lay preacher.

It would appear that very little research in the region was carried out, with regard to the impact of such a thoughtless co-incidence. In my opinion, if you had consulted with people in the region, you would have discovered an overwhelming objection to the name of "Wright" and the distasteful images that the name congers up for Central Queenslanders. The name "Wright" when used in a potical context, and in this instance as the name of a new Federal Electorate, suggests sleaze and disgust to most voters.
