pity.

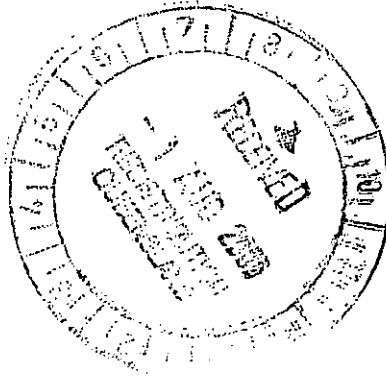
