Dear Sir/Madam

We write to lodge an objection to the proposal to the redistribution of the Fairfax Electoral Boundry. In our opinion, the redistribution will discriminate against us in the light that the Office of the Minister representing

the electorate will be at considerable distance to our place of residence. We find it hard enough at the present time to locate ourselves to the Present Minister (Mr. Slomliye) whose Office is 45 minutes away.

This will become an even greater challenge as we begin to age and the price of petrol increases. Will the

Government be introducing fast and cheap transport to counteract this?

Maryborough is geographically different in terms of industry, climate, distance, population, thought processes.

We do not feel that a Minister, operating some 2 + hours from the major population being represented will be able
