I wish to add my objection to the proposed re-distribution boundaries.

For years this region was well served under Kennedy. Then we were mis-matched with centres such as Emerald and Rockhampton under Capricorn. We felt much more comfortable under Maroon, big as it was, as we were linked with other western shires.

Now we are to be even more mis-matched with Gladstone which is not a centre for most people for business, schooling or recreation. There is not a direct road or any air connection, so we are worse off than when linked with Rockhampton.

It is difficult for poorly populated western shires to have a voice in government but is even more so when split up and joined with industrial areas.
