I am writing to protest the proposed changing of the suburb of Algerster from the Morton electorate to the Oxley electorate

I have read that when changing boundaries certain things are to be taken into account i.e. community interest, communication and transport links, natural features and current boundaries

Of the above I find not one of the interests appear to be have taken into account.

There is very little community interest from Algerster to the west (or vice versa) due to the fact there is little in the way of communication, this is due to the fact that the main North South railway forms a natural barrier between the Morton and Oxley electorates as does the Oxley creek water catchment area.


