I wish to object to the proposed redistribution which would see my vote and others from Neutral Bay and Cremorne shifted to the seat of Warringah from the current seat of North Sydney.

The suburbs of Neutral Bay and Cremorne have overwhelming community relationships with the North Sydney electorate and geographical area and little or no relationship to the Warringah area. The suburbs are of course a major part of the North Sydney council area.

In addition not only is the Spit Bridge a natural boundary, both the suburbs are separated from Mosman and the suburbs further east in the Warringah electorate by the traffic issues on Military Road. Both Neutral Bay and Cremorne retain easy access to North Sydney and adjacent areas without the delays with travel on the Mosman to Spit Bridge section of Military Road and Spit Road.
