If the proposed change were to proceed Bundeena's isolation would be greatly increased. Rather than being represented via our local centre in Sutherland we would be connected to a strip of coast with which we have very little in common, and with the added buffer of the National Park on top of this! The Residents of Bundeena would become the definition of marginalised (to treat a person, group, or concept as insignificant or peripheral!) I believe that a vast majority (over 90%) of people would find themselves in the very unusual position whereby they operate in one electorate and vote and vote in another! A very disempowering position to be in.
