We wish to advise that we object to Neutral Bay (and other parts of our local community) being included in the Warringah federal electoral area.

Our reasons are as follows:

- We do not share community and regional interests with any of the communities North of the Spit bridge.
- The Spit Bridge does not link the 2 communities on the North and South of the Spit, which is a clear identifiable boundary between 2 very different communities.
- The Warringah Expressway does not divide North Sydney. The suburb of North Sydney as well as those suburbs within the North Sydney local government area, are spread over both sides of the expressway, the local population consider themselves to be a part of the North Sydney community.
- Dividing the existing local government area into separate Federal electorates would divide the community.

REDISTRIBUTION NSW

- The existing North Sydney electorate should continue to be represented by one Federal member.
- We do not believe that the Warringah Federal member will adequately represent the communities South of the Spit bridge.
