Dear Sir or Madam

I have been a resident of North Cremorne and the North Sydney LGA for 31 years.

I object to the proposed transfer of over 14,000 voters in North Cremorne from the Division of North Sydney to Warringah for the purpose of offsetting a transfer of a similar number from Willoughby for the purposes of achieving numerical tolerance. North Sydney and Warringah already met this numerical tolerance criteria.

Although I am a resident within the North Sydney LGA and there is State electorate of North Sydney and a Federal electorate of North Sydney, the proposed distribution will mean that for NSW State elections I will be in the Willoughby electorate and for Federal elections I will be in the Warringah electorate.

There is no identifiable link between Cremorne and the Warringah electorate given the physical boundary of middle harbour. This is much more identifiable boundary than the proposed Mowbray Road boundary referred to in the AEC report.

Why do the residents of the Willoughby LGA have a greater claim of being part of the North Sydney Division than residents of the North Sydney LGA.
