To Whom it May Concern:

Please let the Kuranda District remain in the electoral boundaries of Leichardt and NOT transfer to Kennedy!

The Kuranda District is already disadvantaged by it's local government boundaries due to our significant difference in characteristics to the rest of the Tablelands Shire Council. With many outreach services already in place and coming from the Cairns district rather than any other places - to change this would seriously disadvantage and disrupt Kuranda. The Cairns centre is best placed and has already gone through the lengthy process of consultation and negotiation with current government to ensure adequate service coverage for the Kuranda District.

Of equal importance is the local Indigenous Djabuguy Tribal boundaries. To change these coastal (rainforest) clan groupings would be a cultural and social disaster.
