This application form is used by registered significant third parties and associated entities who wish to deregister under section 287M of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918* (Electoral Act).

- Applications will only be approved where the Electoral Commissioner is satisfied that the person or entity no longer meets the requirements for registration as a significant third party or associated entity (as the case requires). Otherwise, the Commissioner must refuse the application.
