

Internal Review of Public Access Terminals and Party Registration Processes

The AEC regularly reviews its processes through a variety of mechanisms to support and enhance its services. We have initiated a review of how the AEC discharges its obligations with respect to Public Access Terminals and Party Registration. Both processes require the AEC to effectively manage our legislative obligations, democratic principles, privacy requirements and information security.

This internal review will consider what adjustments, if any, the AEC should make to meet these requirements. The review may also identify potential areas for legislative reform for the consideration of the Joint Standing Committee on Electoral Matters and the Special Minister of State.

The internal review will conclude in the first half of 2026. The AEC may progressively implement changes during the review period. The AEC will publish information on its website about any changes, including information about how they may affect the use of Public Access Terminals and applicants for party registration.
