As discussed, here is a copy of the draft MV4 form. This will be the cover sheet that DROs will be expected to complete for each multi-mark instance and will form the basis of the information used by national office to code cases to an AFP Case Category.

Would you be able to take a look and provide any feedback.

I've also included the below table which gives early indication of 3+ marks at the state level.
