## **Objections to Electoral; Redistribution of North Sydney Electorate**

I am a long-term resident of Cremorne and strongly object to the AEC's proposal to redistribute our electorate to adjoining electorates for the following reasons –

1. North Sydney is a founding electorate with a long tradition and proud history of community based representation both at State and Federal levels. Few, if any, other electorates would have this. There is a danger that splitting the electorate and distribution to adjoining electorates would destroy that strong sense of community.
2. The projected population growth in the electorate would suggest there would be a strong case for reestablishing the electorate in a decade's time and at what cost to our community (see 1).
3. The business centre is one of the largest in Australia and demands an economic and cultural focus to reinforce its importance to the nation.
4. We do not share the needs or wants of adjoining electorates. Warringah and Bradfield are largely residential, light industry and low rise.
