# OVERVIEW

Please accept my suggestions for the 2023 redistribution of New South Wales electoral divisions. Population growth in NSW has slowed and this is reflected in NSW being required to reduce the number of electoral divisions from 47 to 46.

Population change has been extremely uneven resulting in high growth areas in Western Sydney and the Lower Hunter, whilst there have been very low growth rates in Eastern Sydney and some regional areas. This has resulted in a high number of divisions being either well above or well below the required enrolment guidelines.

The uneven growth rates as well as the need to reduce the number of divisions means that radical changes will be required in some areas.

## ENROLMENT PROJECTIONS

The enrolment projections provided by the AEC have been adopted for this submission. Overall, the aim has been to try to be as close to the mid-point in the 2028 forecast period. This task has been made more challenging by concentrations of growth in South Western Sydney in particular.

The enrolment projections for 2023 and 2028 have been provided in the summary for each division.

## BOUNDARY DETERMINATION

In developing boundaries for electoral divisions, a range of criteria have been used:

- Readily identifiable natural features such as rivers of the Great Dividing Range.
- Major infrastructure that can provide a legible boundary – main roads, freeways, railway lines.
- Community of Interest – trying to combine likeminded communities by local government area, transport routes, or in regional areas, linking the rural hinterland with major regional centres.
- ABS SA2 boundaries – wherever possible though some SA2 areas have been split along SA1 boundaries. Wherever possible these have been drawn on recognizable and legible boundaries – main roads.

The aim, wherever possible, has been to keep suburbs and their focal points in one division. If a boundary is required, the preference has been to split minor centres rather than major centres.

All maps are based on Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) mapping tools.

## POLITICAL OUTCOMES

Political outcomes and how the proposed boundaries may affect the interest of any political party has not been a determining factor in this submission.

# SUMMARY

The NSW entitlement of electoral divisions in the Commonwealth House of Representatives has been reduced to 46. The abolition of a division will require some degree of change as well as having to accommodate uneven growth rates.

The summary of the proposed changes are:

- Two divisions are proposed to be abolished – Warringah and Grayndler. Both are in low growth areas.
- A new Western Sydney Division is proposed in South Western Sydney. This would extend from the M4 Motorway southwards and include parts of Penrith, Badgery's Creek, and include parts of Camden and Campbelltown around Harrington and Oran Parks.
- As a result of Warringah being abolished – northern Sydney divisions would need to move eastwards.
- As enrolments are low in Eastern Sydney, Wentworth is proposed into the eastern part of the City of Sydney.
- The abolished Grayndler will largely be replaced by Sydney moving westwards into Balmain and Leichhardt, and Barton taking the remainder of Marrickville. The Haberfield and Ashfield North areas would go to Reid.
- Newcastle is the only division proposed to be unchanged.
- It is proposed that Inland NSW have defined 'inland divisions' with Eden Monaro moved toward the coast and to include Goulburn.
- The proposed Hume boundaries remove the 'dumb bell' and unite Wingecaribbee Shire with Wollondilly and Camden.
- Whitlam is proposed to be a coastal seat division only taking in southern Wollongong and Shellharbour.
- Cunningham is proposed to move north into the Heathcote, Engadine, Yarrawarra and Bundeena parts of the Sutherland Shire.
- Cook is proposed to be a Sutherland Shire seat only.
- Hughes would cross the Georges River and take in Revesby and Panania as well as retaining the Menai / Illawong areas and part of Sutherland.
- Banks is proposed to move east taking in the north side of the Georges River from Lugarno to Botany Bay taking electors from Cook and Barton.
- Major changes are proposed in Western Sydney: Macquarie to move east to take in Penrith; the Hawkesbury part of Macquarie to be combined with the northern part of Greenway to form a distinct North Western Sydney division.
- Lindsay, Chifley, McMahon and Parramatta would each shuffle eastwards.




Minor adjustments only proposed to the Division of Richmond. These are proposed to accommodate more substantial enrolment changes further south in the northern coastal region.






The Division of Paterson has been growing quickly and it is forecast that it will be substantially over quota. Therefore, significant changes will be required.

- Maitland (North), Rutherford (North) - Aberglassyn SA2 to be transferred to Paterson. This will unite almost all of the City of Maitland within Paterson


The Division of Dobell requires changes to balance forecast elector numbers to North and South.




Changes proposed to the Division of Berowra are:


The Division of Bradfield has projected elector numbers well under the forecast range. Therefore it will need to gain electors from neighbouring divisions. The proposed division has two foci – Ku Ring Gai to the west and the Frenchs Forest / Belrose area to the east.

Changes proposed to the Division of Bradfield are:

- SA2 areas from Bradfield north of the Pacific Motorway: Asquith - Mount Colah, Hornsby – East, Normanhurst - Thornleigh – Westleigh, Wahroonga (West) – Waitara transferred to Berowra.
- The suburb of Chatswood (based on ABS boundaries) be consolidated in Bradfield.
- The Frenchs Forest and Belrose areas east of Middle Harbour and west of the Wakehurst Parkway be consolidated into the one division – they are currently split.







## Division of Wentworth




The existing Division of Wentworth has the lowest enrolment of any NSW division. To meet the minimum 2028 requirement, it needs almost 23,000 additional electors.

It is proposed that the SA2s of Darlinghurst, Potts Point – Woollahra and Surry Hills be transferred to Wentworth from Sydney. These additional areas have a strong community of interest with neighbouring areas in Wentworth and have more in common with these than with areas in the west of the City of Sydney.

The existing southern boundary with Kingsford – Smith is proposed to remain unchanged.




The Division of Kingsford-Smith is required to gain electors so that it achieve the quota range.



It is proposed that the SA2s of Darlinghurst, Potts Point – Woolloomooloo and Surry Hills be transferred to Wentworth. The SA2 of Zetland and that part of Rosebery-Beaconsfield SA2 east of Botany Road are proposed to be moved to Kingsford-Smith .

It is proposed that Balmain, Rozelle, Leichhardt, Annandale and Stanmore north of the railway line be transferred from Grayndler.



# Proposed New Western Sydney Division




Enrolment numbers in South Western Sydney have been growing steadily. Even though NSW as a whole needs to lose a division, growth rates in this region – especially compared to other parts in the state – warrant an additional division so that enrolment targets can be achieved.

The proposed New Western Sydney Division (at this stage not named) takes in electors from six existing divisions. High growth rates are forecast to continue and the proposed division moves from the low end of the 2023 quota to the high end of the forecast 2028 enrolments.

The proposed division has the M4 Motorway as its northern boundary, Cowpastures Road as eastern boundary, The Northern Road and Nepean River as western boundaries.

## Division of Macquarie


The Division of Greenway has been growing rapidly and needs to transfer electors to other divisions to maintain the quota guidelines. Major changes are proposed.
