I write in objection of the Redistribution Committee's proposal.

I disagree with the rationale of part 80 and thus the conclusion of part 81, both parts found on page 33.

I thus disagree with the proposal of abolishing an Eastern electoral division.

I believe a northern or western division should be abolished. Specifically Gorton or Hawke.

I object to neither Hawke or Gorton being investigated for abolition, Table 1:electoral divisions the redistribution committee investigated for abolition.

I also disagree with the proposed electoral map as I believe the present Divisions of Chisholm, Kooyong, Hotham, Kooyong, Macnamara and Melbourne are not afforded attention in the proposed division changes caused by abolishing Higgins of their electorates community of interests within the proposed electoral divisions, including economic, social and regional interests, nor means of communication and **travel within proposed electoral divisions**, the physical features and area of the proposed electoral division and the boundaries of existing divisions.

I ask the Members of the augmented electoral commission of Victoria, within in the confines of the act, to seriously consider all objections and proposed ideas of how to accommodate Victoria needing to abolish a Division while creating a new map that sets up Victoria and Melbourne's Peri-Urban growth for the future inside electorates that are orderly and community oriented.
