Details: IF the name of Franklin is to be changed the suggestion of Tongerlongeter is highly inappropriate due to the violent incidents in which this person was involved (regardless of the justification for his people at the time).

Also, given the low literacy levels in Tasmania, the name is a bridge too far for both spelling and pronunciation.

I would suggest the name REECE, for the late Eric Reece, or possibly GOODWIN, in memory of the late Vanessa Goodwin.

However, if an aboriginal name is preferred it should be simple and easily pronounced, eg. TIPINA or TUKANA. Both are names from within the proposed new electorate boundaries and both used by the Oyster Bay tribe.
