In the main, divisions should be named after deceased Australians who have rendered outstanding service to their country.

When new divisions are created the names of former Prime Ministers should be considered.

Retain Franklin (Head of State).

Federation Divisional names

Every effort should be made to retain the names of original federation divisions.

Retain Franklin, as it's the original near-Federation 1903 electorate name.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander names

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander names should be used where appropriate and as far as possible existing Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander divisional names should be retained.

Other criteria

Names of divisions should not be changed or transferred to new areas without very strong reasons. When two or more divisions are partially combined, as far as possible the name of the new division should

be that of the old division which had the greatest
number of electors within the new boundaries.
