Details: The Federal electorate of Grey carries the name of a significant South Australian figure, Sir George Grey, the third governor of South Australia and an important figure in our States history. The names of our electorates reflect the states history and the individuals who helped shape it. Preserving such names maintains continuity with our past and provides a tangible link to the foundations of our institutions. While recognising Indigenous heritage is important, renaming long-established electorates risks erasing layers of history rather than adding to them. A more constructive approach is to honour Indigenous Australians in other ways landmarks ensuring recognition is expanded, not substituted.
