Could you please amend my submission to the following:

Regarding the boundary redistribution and naming of Grey. Firstly whilst I have the utmost respect for Lowitja O'Donoghue I think the change of naming would make things difficult in regards to the spelling of the electorate name. This name is not easy to spell correctly and the name Grey is short easy and also representative of another wonderful politician who represented the area in the past. Whilst it would be a wonderful way to honour Lowitja I do not think naming an electorate is the best way to do this. Also in regards to the expansion of Grey I am strongly opposed to this. As a resident of the electorate and the need to cover such a big area and sufficiently represent the electors in a suitable way will become virtually impossible. I am aware of the need for a population quota for each House of Representatives seat but the current electorate of Grey is already 903,000 square kms which is huge and an increase to that expanse is just plain unfair and unworkable for the member to service effectively. Country electors deserve better and there must be a fairer way to work out this representation than basing it purely on population. Some city members of parliament service electorates only a few kms long verses some country MP's servicing an electorate thousands of kms long and expansion of an electorate such as Grey is just unworkable. There has to be a better way. Please do not put the current or future members of this seat at any further disadvantage or add any additional pressure to their already difficult jobs.
