I strongly agree with the recognition of Dr Lowitja O’Donohue in this manner but I would advocate that the name Lowitja would be more appropriate as it is a recognition of her Indigenous heritage and the life she devoted to her people and the wider community.

The Lowitja Institute and the biennial Lowitja Lectures already acknowledge the use of the name Lowitja rather than the use of the surname, O’Donoghue or her married name, Smart.

I live in the electorate of Grey and my late husband Barry was the Member for Grey 1993 to 2007 and this name change is of great interest to me.
