I oppose the proposed boundary changes to Grey because it is, and should remain, a distinctly regional electorate focused on representing rural and remote South Australian communities. Expanding Grey to include parts of metropolitan growth areas would shift that focus, diluting the voices of regional communities and blending very different needs and priorities into one electorate. The scale of Grey already presents significant challenges for effective representation, and adding urban areas would only increase that complexity while reducing the ability to advocate strongly for rural issues. These changes risk weakening the clear regional identity of Grey and undermining the quality of representation for the communities it is meant to serve
